Pet Park and Registration

The dog park located by the storage units on the west end of 1530 N is up and running. We are waiting on the sign with the rules on it and a few other amenities such as benches but you may go ahead and use it. All dogs must be registered with the HOA and receive an HOA tag to use the park. Contact Connie to register your pet and receive the tag.

Bridgerland Meadows Dog Park Rules

- Use park at your own risk
- Owners are legally responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) at all times
- Dogs must be leashed while entering and exiting the park.
- Dog waste must be cleaned up by their owners IMMEDIATELY.
- Owners must be within the dog park and supervising their dog with leash readily available.
- Dogs with HOA registration & HOA tags only
- Must have current vaccinations
- Dog handlers must be at least 16 years of age.
- Children under 13 must be accompanied by an adult and supervised at all times.
- Aggressive dogs must be removed immediately.
- Dogs should be under voice control
- Bridgerland Meadows HOA is not responsible for injury or illness to dogs or owners.

PROHIBITED:

Human treats Aggressive dogs

Dogs in heat Puppies (under 4 months)

Sick dogs Glass containers

• Prohibited: Bicycles, Children's Toys, Strollers
